The Continuing Competence Program (CCP) audit notices will be sent out by email in March. Please ensure your email address is up-to-date and the CMLTA is on your 'safe senders' list. If you are chosen for the CCP audit, there is no immediate action required on your part as all required information will have been submitted as part of your renewal.

If your CCP complies with the CMLTA requirements, you will receive a notice that you have passed. If your CCP has any issues, you will receive an email notification and a letter sent by registered mail to inform you. This notice will give you detailed specifics of what needs to be fixed and how to re-submit for review.
